Willow Burn Hospice aims to improve the quality of life for those who have life limiting illnesses, and their families, through the provision of high quality palliative care and family support services in County Durham.

It costs £1.2 million a year to provide free palliative and end of life care to those who need it the most. It's a common misconception that hospices are fully funded by the NHS but at Willow Burn we only receive 40% of funding towards the cost of our care.

Each year at Willow Burn we provide:

8760 hours of nursing care 1152 hours of day care 2080 hours of family support and bereavement counselling


